## Leadership

#### **Education**

Fellows design, deliver, and sustain highquality continuing education, training, and mentorship opportunities that specifically address the needs of IENs.

### **Advocacy**

Fellows champion fair, ethical, and inclusive policies for IENs at organizational, local, national, and international levels.

# Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Justice

Fellows advance equity and justice by addressing systemic barriers and discriminatory practices that limit IEN opportunities and representation.

# **Scholarship**

Fellows advance nursing science and practice by conducting research, publishing, and disseminating knowledge that addresses IEN issues.



#### **FELLOWSHIP AWARDS PROCESS**

**Pathway 1:** Professional Recognition Pathway (Portfolio Submission + Viva Voce)

- Submit a statement of intent, CV, and FSIEN Dossier mapping career achievements to the LEADS competencies.
- Provide one professional reference letter and supporting documents (as needed).
- Pay the non-refundable application fee.
- Achieve a minimum overall score of 80% and at least Proficient (4/5) in all LEADS competencies.
- Defend the dossier in a Viva Voce before the Fellowship Review Panel.

**Pathway 2:** Academic Pathway (Course Completion + Viva Voce)

- Submit application to attend the IEN mentorship education course.
- Actively participate in at least 80% of the synchronous educational program.
- Pay the non-refundable application fee.
- Achieve a minimum overall score of 80% all LEADS competencies evaluation
- Develop a Capstone Project that demonstrates the FSIEN competencies
- Defend the capstone in a Viva Voce before the Fellowship Review Panel.
