

Dr. Sawsan Abuhammad holds the PhD degree in Maternal and Child health Nursing from the College of Nursing at the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee, Wisconsin USA, and the BSc in Nursing from the Faculty of Nursing at Jordan University of Science and Technology, Jordan. She is a fellow of the Responsible Conduct of Research Fellowship- a Joint International Degree at University of California/USA, and Jordan University of Science and Technology, Jordan.
